2" Meters: The minimum monthly bill is **\$201.03**

Capital Improvement Charge

Each member account shall be assessed a monthly Capital Improvement Charge in the amount of seventeen dollars (\$17.00) per month.

The purpose of this charge is to provide dedicated funding for MON Water's 20-Year Capital Improvement Plan, including, but not limited to, water main replacements and upsizing, storage tank improvements, booster station upgrades, system reliability improvements, and other necessary infrastructure projects.

This charge is intended to help ensure that the Utility can maintain, repair, replace, and improve critical water system infrastructure in a planned and financially responsible manner. The Capital Improvement Charge shall be billed monthly to each active member account in addition to all other applicable rates, fees, and charges.

Bulk Water Sales

Bulk water sales shall be charged a capital improvement charge of seventeen dollars (\$17.00) per month, in addition to the cost of water used. Water usage for bulk water sales shall be billed at the rate of ten dollars and sixty-five cents (\$10.65) per 1,000 gallons.

New Service Charges

Item	Charge	Description
Membership Fee	\$100.00	Anyone wishing to receive water service from MON Water must be a member of the Utility. A \$100 membership fee is required. Membership fees are refundable when the member discontinues water service; however, any unpaid balance owed to the Utility will be deducted from the membership fee before any refund is issued.
Tap Fee – 5/8" x 3/4"	\$1,815.00 (plus the cost of any required road cut permit)	Each applicant shall pay a charge to cover the cost of excavation and tapping the main; furnishing and installing the service pipe from the main to the lot line; furnishing and installing the corporation stop and curb stop; and furnishing and installing the meter crock, yoke, and setter.
Tap Fee – Larger than 5/8" x 3/4"	Actual Cost but not less than \$1,815.00	The charge for a meter tap larger than 5/8" x 3/4" shall be the actual cost of labor, materials, power machinery, transportation, and overhead incurred in installing the tap.
System Capacity Fee	\$600.00	Each applicant for new water service shall pay a System Capacity Fee in addition to all applicable tap, meter-setting, permit, and membership fees. This fee is intended to recover a portion of the Utility's investment in existing system capacity and infrastructure made available to serve the applicant's property.
Start Up Fee	\$45.00	New members shall pay a nonrefundable startup fee of forty-five dollars (\$45.00). This fee covers the administrative and maintenance costs associated with activating a new membership and is in addition to the membership fee, system capacity fee, and tap fee.

Other Charges

Item	Charge	When Applied
Brown card late notice service fee	\$10.00	Mailed on or around the 9th of the month to accounts with a past-due balance of \$20 or more. May be waived once per life of account for customers with good payment history.
Late charge	3%	Applied to any unpaid portion of the current bill after the due date, generally assessed on the 18th or next business day.
White final notice service fee	\$50.00	Hand-delivered on or around the 22nd of the month to accounts with a balance of \$50 or more.
Reconnection fee	\$50.00	Applied after disconnected service is restored once the account balance is paid in full.
General Service Call	\$50.00	This charge will apply for any trip to a member's premises, at the member's request, during normal business hours for issues located on the member's side of the meter.
After-hours Service Call	\$100.00	This charge will apply for any trip to a member's premises made at the member's request outside of normal business hours, including holidays and weekends.
Bad Check Service Charge	\$25.00	This charge will apply in the event a check, draft, or other payment instrument tendered to the Utility by a customer for payment of water service charges is dishonored by the bank or financial institution upon which it is drawn due to insufficient funds, account closure, or any similar reason.

Data Usage Fees for Sewer Billings

When the Utility provides customer account, water-consumption, meter-reading, billing, or other usage data to another governmental entity, sewer utility, or authorized third party for the purpose of calculating and issuing sewer bills, a data usage fee shall be assessed to recover the Utility's administrative, software, processing, recordkeeping, and data-management costs.
